SAPN EA Update 16-10-2020

Yesterday (Thursday 15/10) our shared struggle for better workplaces had an important win. The SA Power Networks/Enerven Proposed Enterprise Agreement was voted down by a significant majority of workers.

The vote numbers were very strong in rejecting management's proposed EA:

Total votes cast – 1764

Votes to Reject the Proposed EA: 1108 (62.81%)

Votes to Accept the proposed EA: 656 (37.19%)

This shows workers are engaged and watching the EA process closely. We would like to thank our members, Delegates, Workplace Reps and the workers for having conversations in the workplace and taking the time to communicate their views to other workers.

The outcome of this vote sends a strong message to SA Power Networks, there was a lack of meaningful engagement by the company and their offer was not good enough – for many reasons.

The SBU and all of your Bargaining Representatives have told SA Power Networks repeatedly their offer was not good enough, and now they know it's a view supported by the majority of their workforce.

We will be notifying SA Power Networks of a bargaining meeting very soon and we are keen to resume negotiations on behalf of all union members.
