SAPN/Enerven EA Update 12-5-2021

We'd like to thank All Workers who attended last Thursday's Union Rally that was held outside Keswick, as well as those who sent messages of solidarity because they were unable to attend. A video of the day can be found here: <https://youtu.be/ZhigzFhZpXM>

Our rally was in line with a 4 hour stoppage that co-ordinated between all Unions of the SBU. The rally was well attended, and we've received good feedback from our Members. Power Industry Representatives from interstate voiced messages of solidarity from their respective Unions and Memberships. A speaker from Victoria relayed information about similar issues in relation to current bargaining with Powercor and Citipower, who are also owned by CKI Infrastructure. They have predicted they will be lodging a Protected Action Ballot very soon.

We have an EA Bargaining Meeting planned for Thursday the 13th of May at 10am, at the Pier Hotel. In this meeting we will be continuing to work through our claims with SA Power Networks/Enerven. SA Power Networks/Enerven have also listed claims that they would like to speak about. The SA Power Networks/Enerven Log of Claims still presents many concerns for our industry moving forwards.

The current state of negotiations has us reviewing possible clause changes in relation to:

- Dispute Resolution
- Consultation
- Abandonment of Employment
- Midday Meal Allowance
- Annual Leave Cash Out
- Purchased Leave
- Death While Employed
- Selection and Appointment

These are all claims made by SA Power Networks/Enerven and need to be thoroughly assessed and considered before any agreement can be reached.
